



## ARBITRATION GUIDELINES

### Light System

**Green Light** – Ride and drive, no announcement required

**Yellow Light** – Caution, announced condition

**Red Light** – Sold “as-is” due to model year, mileage or announced condition.

### Arbitration

Mechanical defects must exceed \$500 per item to be eligible for arbitration.

All requests for mechanical arbitration must be made the day of sale.

Air conditioning is **not** eligible for arbitration.

Visible body damage, hail, previous paint/ body work is **not** eligible for arbitration.

Glass is **not** eligible for arbitration.

LKAR is **not** responsible for announcing vehicles with or without air conditioning, manual transmissions, and/ or 4x4 or 4x2.

Units selling for \$3,000 or less are **not** eligible for arbitration for any reason, including frame, except odometer rollback. Rollback is defined as a substantiated State Motor Vehicle Record. Carfax an/ or Auto Check reports are **not** eligible.

LKAR will **not** arbitrate any rear end noise of Diamler-Chrysler products regardless of year or mileage.

Dealers must check the odometer to see that it is working prior to leaving the auction.

ABS, SRS, and any other indicator lights are **not** eligible for arbitration unless the \$500 mechanical is surpassed.

All salvage and towed units are **not** eligible for arbitration.

LKAR does not guarantee the validity of any remaining warranty (manufacturers or others) that would appear to accompany the vehicle.

Missing items such as radios, spare tires, etc. are **not** arbitratable.

Inoperable power windows, sunroofs, power locks and like items are **not** arbitratable.

### Frame

Only undisclosed damage that changes the structural integrity of the vehicle is eligible for arbitration.

The following does **not** require announcement: core support damage, horn damage, jackmarks, dents to floor pan or engine cradle, frame rust, distortion to the frame such as towing damage or transport damage tie-down tears, A-B-C pillars on full frame vehicles, or exhaust mounts.\*

Purchaser will agree to pay for transportations and testing if the vehicles are within acceptable Tolerances.

- **No** vehicles will be sold before crossing the block.
- “IF” Sales – Refer to auction policy
- **Titles** – LKAR will have 30 days from day of sale to produce title. 24hr notice must be given to seller. Should LKAR produce the title within 24hrs, sale will remain unchanged.
- Dealer handouts & vehicle window markings are a guide only. Check vehicle equipment, year, & miles against the vehicle. LKAR will not make adjustments for these errors.
- LKAR reserves the right to amend or add to these guidelines in the future.

*\* Tie down tears, dents to floor pan, and distortion will be governed by NAAA structural damage policy – must measure within manufacturer specs and/ or damage less than specified guidelines.*
